walk beside us as we face our daily journey.

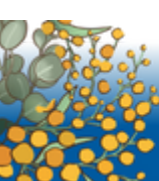

Ever generous God hear our prayer. We ask this through Jesus Christ. Amen.

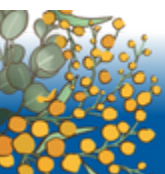
May we, like Mary MacKillop always show kindness to all, in the way we think, speak, and act. Amen
